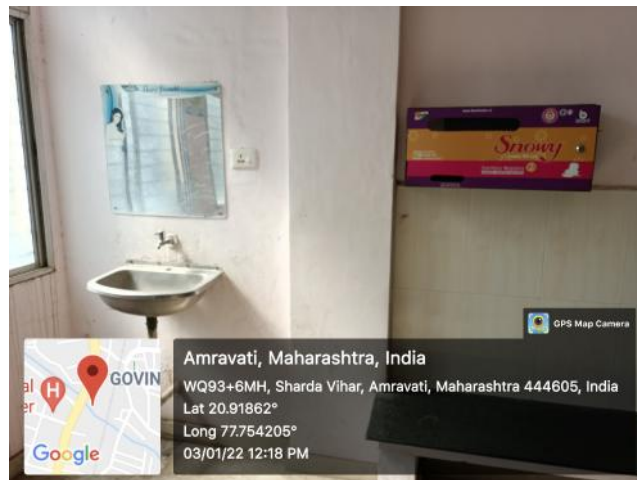
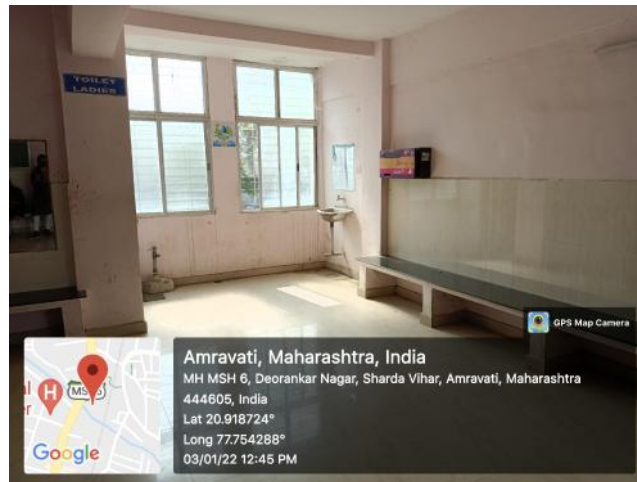

### Outcome of Programme:-

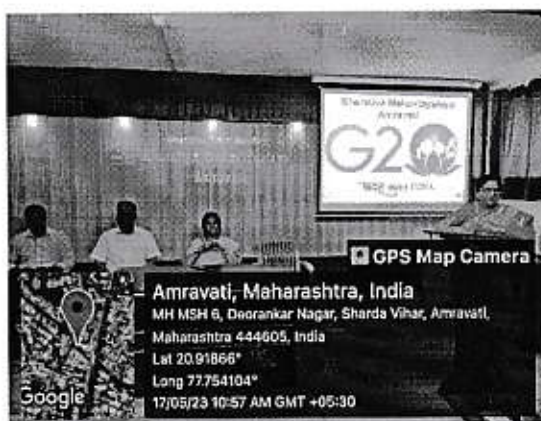

<b>Outcome of the Programme</b>	Awareness regarding social accountability was created and the attendees were sensitised towards gender discrimination.

**Report** : The President of Interdisciplinary one day National Conference was Dr. Aradhana Vaidya, Principal Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati. It was attended by eminent personalities Dr. Hina Kausar Khan well known columnist and journalist, Dr. Mona Chimote, Dean, Faculty of Humanities, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati, Shayra Banno, Vice President, Uttarakhand Commission for Women, Dr. Alka Deshmukh, President, Council of Political Science Professors, Nagpur, Prof. Chaya Jadhav Vice President, Dr. VM Peshwa Social Research Institute Yavatmal, Dr. Benita Raphael, Dr. Vineet Kaur, and Dr. Dr. Alka Gaikwad.

Due to the efforts of Shayra Banno, the Indian government repealed the triple talaq law. National Human Rights Award for this. The form of the award was given with a cash amount of 25 thousand rupees, badge of honor, shawl, shripal, plant.

**First Session** : Inaugurating the session, Dr. Mona Chimote said that the sensitivity of the society is running out. She asserted the need for organized opposition. On this occasion, Principal Dr. Aradhana Vaidya said that no matter where a woman is, she has to face and deal with the male mentality rampant in the Indian social system. Thus it is more than necessary for the minority women to understand the rights given in the Indian constitution and apply it in real life.

**Second Session** : The second session was presided by Dr. Alka Gaikwad, famous speaker and scholar of Maharashtra and Head of Marathi Department, Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati. keynote speaker was Dr. Benita Raphael, scholar of Christianity Dr. Shubhangi Gopilwar.





In the second session, Dr. Alka Gaikwad talked on the status of Women in Jainism. She stressed that even Jainism is a very ancient religion and emerged 200 years before Buddhism but like every religion it also needs to reflect on the discriminating thoughts of men and women in their religion. She drew an analogy that if a rotten part is not removed by surgery, it festers the whole body. The famous speaker of Maharashtra said that if the rotten thinking in religion is not removed, even religion cannot maintain and enrich the society.

In this lecture series, while speaking on 'Human Rights of Minority Women in Current Perspective', Dr. Benita Raphael said that foeticide has no place in Christianity and gives full respect to women. Early marriage is not practiced in Christian society. Thus, women get enough time to develop their personality. At the same time, it is asserted that the wisdom of choosing a life partner also develops in them. On this occasion,

**Third Session** : President of the third session Dr. Pratibha Bhorjar, Chief Speaker Dr. Vineet Kaur, Chief Guest Dr. Reeta Dandekar were present on the dais. Speaking on the topic 'Progress and Challenges of Minority Women in India', Dr. Pratibha Bhorjar said that when the feeling of friendship between men and women is fully cultivated, that's when Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's thoughts can be put into practical action. For that, it is necessary to change the male mentality.

Next, Dr. Vineet Kaur talking about Sikhism said that women in Sikh society have a respectable place and are not treated as inferior beings. The birth of a girl child is not considered inauspicious. A Sikh woman does not wear a veil. Dowry and divorce are not accepted in Sikhism. Women have the same opportunities as men to achieve their religious, and spiritual development.





