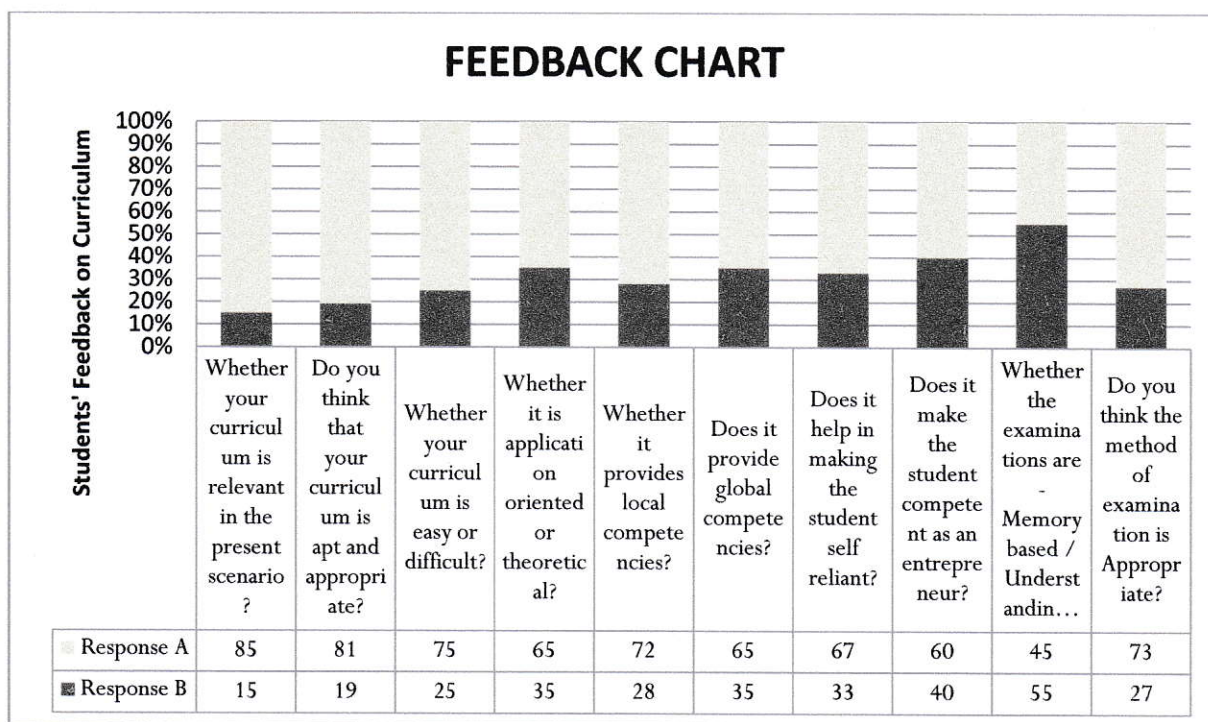

ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM
2021-2022



According to the analysis following major points have been noticed.

- It is analyzed that 85% of the students found curriculum relevant in the present scenario.
- 81% of the students found it apt and appropriate.
- For the 75% of the students, the syllabus was easy. 28% of the students suggested simplifying it by making some positive changes.
- 65% of the students found the syllabus application-oriented.
- Nearly 72 % of students found the curriculum matching to the local and 65% found the curriculum matching to global competencies.
- The same number of students found the curriculum helpful in making the students self-reliant and competent as an entrepreneur.
- 45% of the students found the syllabus memory-based and 55% found it understanding-based.
- 73% of the students thought the method of examination appropriate. Rest of the students suggested making it more efficient.

Suggestions:

- Difficulty level of the curriculum should be decided taking into consideration the background of the student.
- Curriculum should be more application-oriented to suit the needs of the changing world.
- Examination method should be more efficient to evaluate the students at college and university level.

Suggestions given by the students were discussed in the IQAC meetings and the same were conveyed to College Development Committee (CDC).

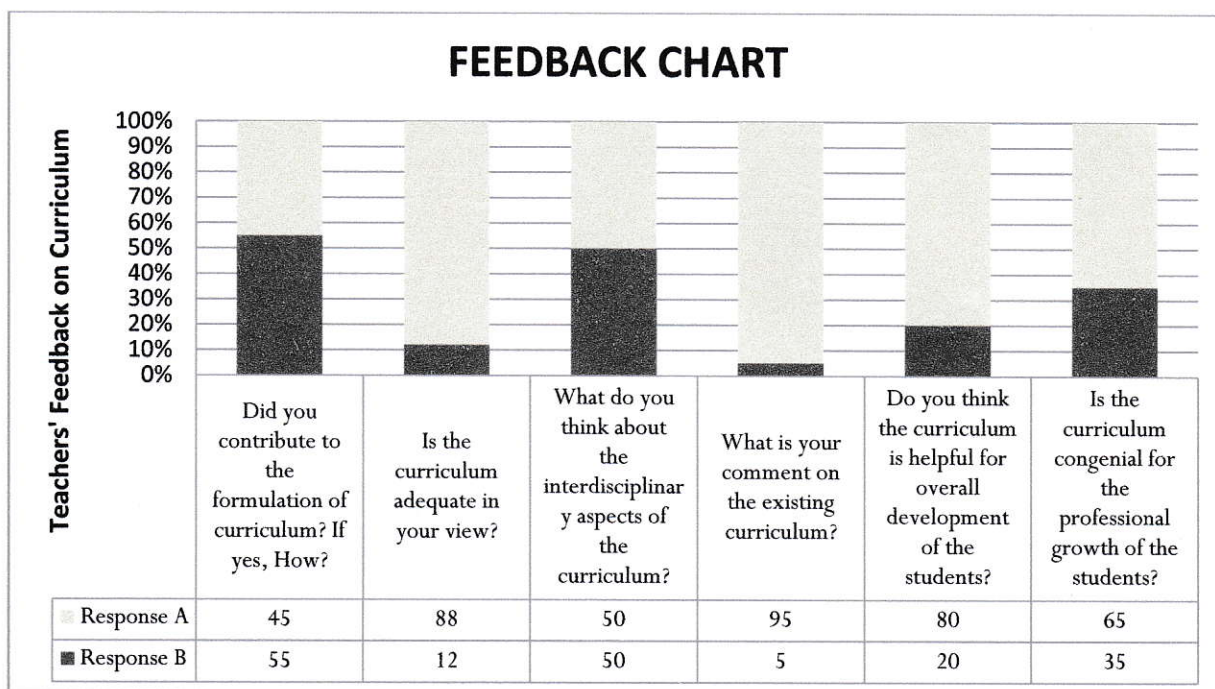

FEEDBACK OF TEACHERS ON CURRICULUM

2021-2022

There were 6 questions in the feedback form. Collection of feedback forms has been done from teachers of Arts, Commerce and Science Faculty. According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed:

Most of the teachers have no direct role to play in the formation of syllabus as the college adheres to the curriculum framed by the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. Teachers convey their suggestions to the Board of Studies members in the college. Nearly 50% of the teachers are the members of Board of Studies and contribute in framing the syllabus.



- Nearly 88% of the teachers found the syllabus adequate.
- 50% of the teachers were in favour of interdisciplinary aspects of curriculum but 50% thought it would create confusion among students if not properly implemented.
- Most of the teachers found a need to make the curriculum more application oriented.
- More than 80% of the teachers thought the curriculum helpful in overall development of the students.
- 65% of the teachers were of the view that the curriculum is congenial for professional growth of the students.

Suggestions:

- Teachers suggested framing of syllabus considering the level and the background of the students.
- Most of the teachers advised proper functioning of newly-introduced Semester pattern.
- There should be gradual development in the difficulty level of the syllabus.

FEEDBACK OF EMPLOYER ON CURRICULUM

2021-2022

The Feedback Form for Employer on Curriculum contained 5 questions. Feedback was taken from 10 Employers. The collection of the form was done by visiting the concerned stakeholder.

According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed.

- Employers found curriculum partially relevant for employability.
- They found the curriculum effective in developing Innovative thinking but stressed the need to implement it properly.
- According to them, the curriculum is mostly effective in developing Skill Oriented Human resources.
- They also found the syllabus need based.
- Employers were divided on the effectiveness of curriculum for development of entrepreneurship.

Suggestions:

- Curriculum should help students in developing professional skills.

- Personality Development & Communication Skill should be an integral part of Syllabus.
- Every college should be given strict directions to start a few courses to inculcate entrepreneurship skills among students.

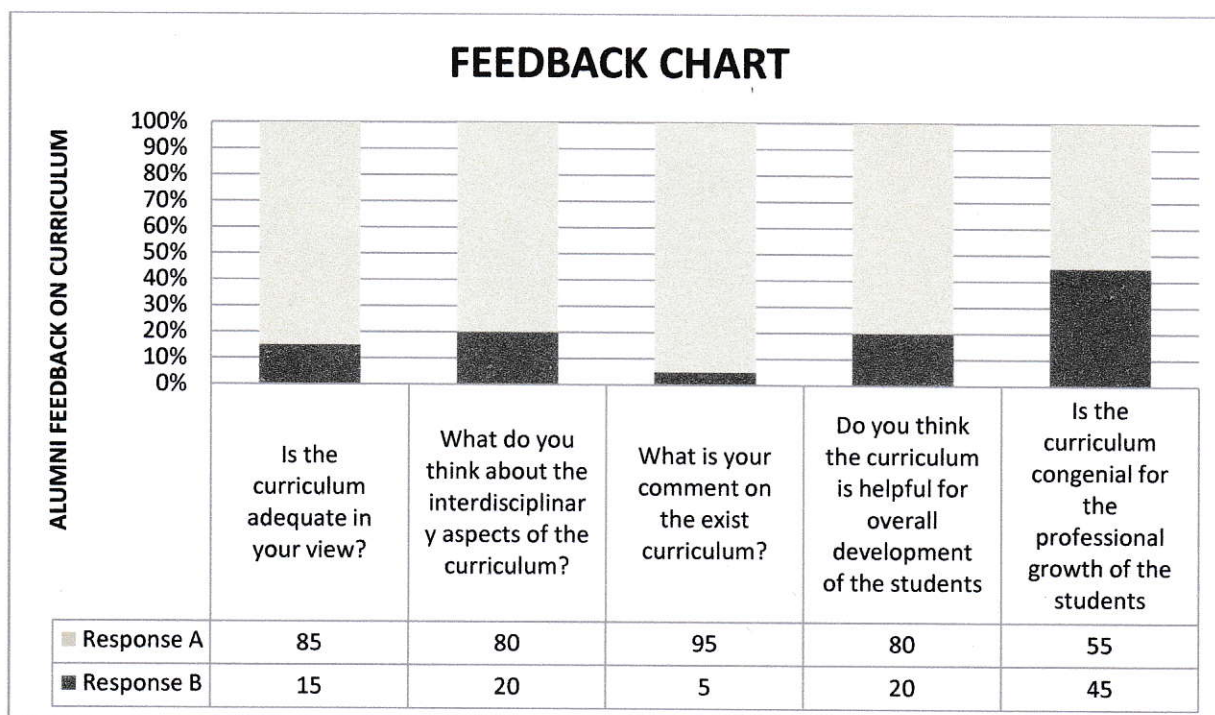
IQAC discussed the suggestions given by the teachers in the meeting and decided to convey the same to the College Development Committee (CDC).

FEEDBACK OF ALUMNI ON CURRICULUM

2021-2022

The Feedback Form for Alumni on Curriculum contained 5 questions. Feedback was taken from 15 alumni. The collection of the form was done at the time of Alumni Meet.



According to the analysis, following major points have been noticed.

- The curriculum was found adequate by more than 85% of the alumni.
- Interdisciplinary aspects of the curriculum were welcomed by 80% of the alumni.
- Most of the alumni were satisfied with the existing curriculum and suggested some positive changes.
- Nearly 80% of the alumni found the curriculum helpful for overall development of the student.

- Alumni were divided over the congeniality of the syllabus for professional growth.

Suggestions:

- Alumni stressed the importance for the professional side of the syllabus.
- Some of the alumni from industrial sector suggested addition of vocational courses in the curriculum.
- Alumni stressed the need for reforms in Curriculum and the Examination method.
