1. Objective of MOU

The objectives of the MOU are.....

- To promote and enhance academic interest between Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati and Avirat
- To conduct financial awareness programme in College Premises.
- To Encourage bright students of Graduate & Post Graduate courses to come for Financial education
- To promote research / Continuing financial education activates between institutions.

2. Technical Areas of Collaborations

- Conducting financial awareness programs to improve financial literacy at Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati Faculty of Avirat could also sent experts for necessary guidance.
- Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati on topics of financial awareness.
- Provide necessary help in organizing workshops and financial awareness program at Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty staff and students of Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati & Society.

- Usage of academic infrastructure of Avirat for workshop students and faculty members.
- To provide summer training for third year student of Bharatiya Mahavidyalaya, Amravati under programmes of Avirat.

- Register candidates for organizing training programmes.

3. Proposed modes of Collaborations

4. Force Majeure

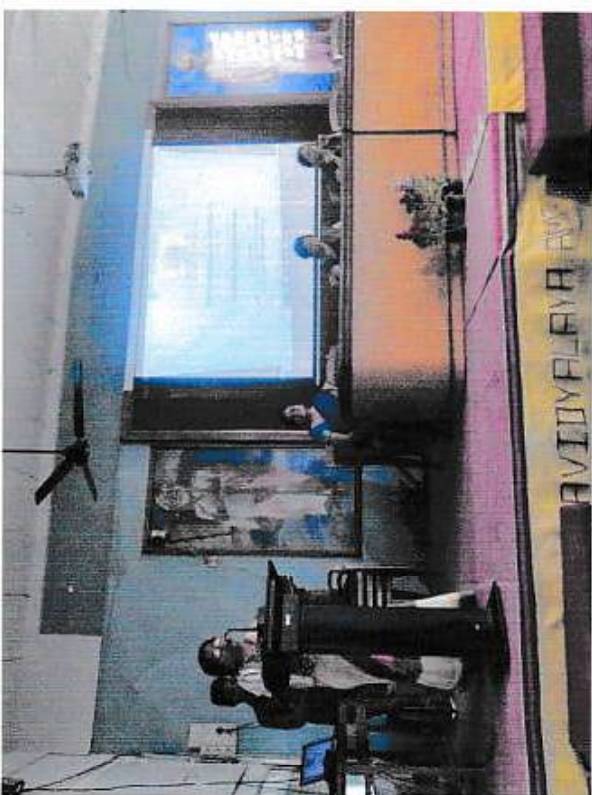
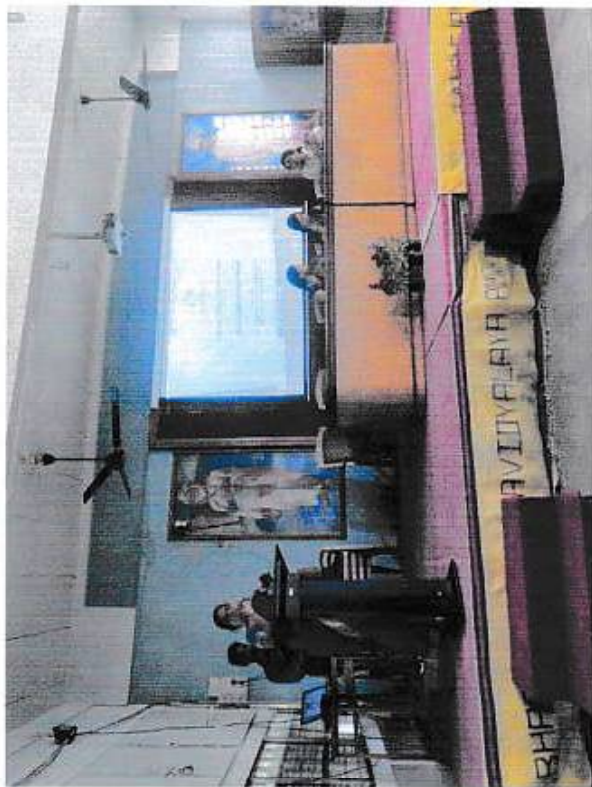
